## Hunting Gear List, continued

### DO NOT BRING

- No Muzzle brake on guns (guide ear safety and anyone else)
- No semi auto guns (cannot pack gun loaded , too loud to load)
- No noisy rain pants rub together or on bushes to check most sound quite in store.
- No Orange is needed but can if you wish
- No new boots they must be broke in (get wet worn till dry)wear for one week

### Suggestions

Layers are better than one big coat we might start out walking for 1/2 hour (sweat) in dark then sitting for first hour of light while it is cold.
